\$1,500.00 O'Neill level

Named after Chief Francis O'Neill, an Irish-American who contributed to preserving the music of his homeland. In the early 20th century he collected and published nearly every Irish tune he knew and learned in a famous tunebook called: "O'Neills Music of Ireland."
